A Message of Thanks from the Oncology Nursing Foundation

As we reflect on 2022, we are extremely grateful for the unwavering support and dedication of our donors, volunteers, friends, and the oncology nursing community. It was an exceptional year of fundraising for oncology nurses. Supporters from across the world came together to advance cancer care and uplift the oncology nursing profession.

In 2022, more than 100 volunteers generously gave their time to assist the Foundation in the scientific and peer review of scholarship and grant applications, and the immense generosity of our donors enabled us to **provide more than \$1.3 million in funding**.

- **\$516,000** for academic scholarships
- **\$738,459** for research grants
- **\$111,048** for conference scholarships
- **\$26,579** for career development awards

Through these investments, the Foundation is steadfast in its commitment to ensuring that oncology nurses have access to resources that can help them enhance their skills and knowledge, ultimately improving patient care and outcomes.

We are extremely grateful to all of our champions, supporters, and volunteers for all that you do!

Highlights From 2022

- The Foundation celebrated the return to in-person events at the 47th Annual ONS Congress® in Anaheim, CA, and raised \$22,500 in donations from individuals inspired by a \$10,000 challenge gift from Mona Stage, BSN, RN, OCN®-Emeritus.
- Seventy-five ONS chapters participated in the 12th Annual Parade of Chapters and raised \$91,275—setting a new record for the event.
- A new system to streamline applications for awards, grants, and scholarships was launched at apply.onfgivesback.org.
- [More than \\$730,000 was invested](#) in awards for 11 research projects covering a range of oncology nursing topics in areas identified in the ONS Research Agenda.
- [Eighty-nine academic scholarships were awarded](#) to aspiring oncology nursing students across the United States, totaling \$516,000 from the Foundation's endowment and special funds.
- The [2022 Mara Mogensen Flaherty Memorial Lecture](#) was awarded to Peggy S. Burhenn, MS, Gero-BC RN, AOCNS®, highlighting the importance of gero-oncology care, the gold standards of older adult patient care, and teaching oncology nurses to incorporate the principles into practice.
- Kathleen Shannon Dorcy, PhD, RN, FAAN, received the [2022 Connie Henke Yarbro Excellence in Cancer Nursing Mentorship Award](#), recognizing her more than 30 years of teaching and mentoring nurses.

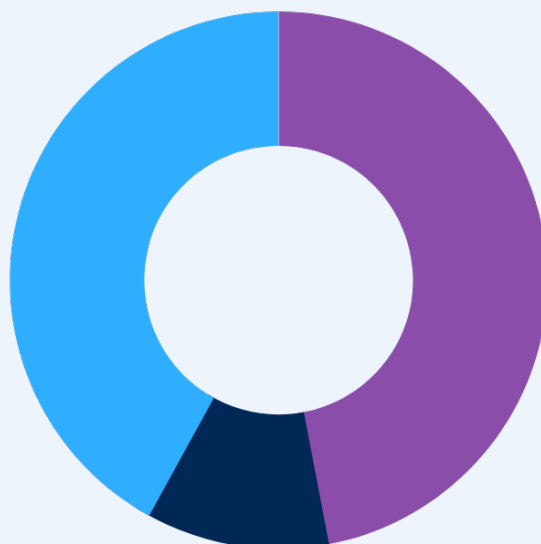
