For more than four decades, the Oncology Nursing Foundation has been dedicated to advancing oncology nursing excellence through philanthropy. Thanks to the generosity of donors and partners like you, we have funded critical research, provided life-changing educational opportunities, and invested in the future of oncology nursing. Today, as we come together to honor the Oncology Nursing Society's 50th anniversary, we celebrate how philanthropy has shaped our past, strengthened our present, and is paving the way for the future.

In 2024, we reached a major milestone with the launch of the Imagining the Possibilities campaign, a bold initiative to raise at least \$8 million to sustain and expand support for oncology nurses. This campaign is already making an impact—creating flexible funding to address emerging needs and establishing the first-of-its-kind Connie Henke Yarbro Oncology Nursing History Center, which preserves and honors the legacy of our profession while inspiring generations to come.

Over the past year, your generosity has made a profound difference:

- **Academic Scholarships:** We provided a total of \$250,500 in academic scholarships to deserving individuals pursuing education and training in oncology nursing.
- **Research Grants:** We awarded nearly \$200,000 to oncology nurse scientists leading innovative studies that will shape the future of patient care.
- **Conference Scholarships:** More than **\$160,000** in **scholarships** allowed nurses to attend professional development events, broadening their expertise and networks.
- Career Development Awards: We invested \$28,000 in continuing education, empowering nurses to advance their skills and leadership in oncology care.

None of this would have been possible without our dedicated community, including more than 190 volunteers, who reviewed applications, mentored emerging leaders, and ensured equitable access to funding. We also hosted a research-intensive workshop for early-career nurse scientists, equipping them with the tools and mentorship needed to advance their work

As we reflect on the incredible energy and inspiration shared recently at the 50th Annual ONS Congress®, we are reminded of the power of this milestone year—and the importance of sustaining that momentum. Philanthropy has always been at the heart of our mission, and your continued support ensures that oncology nurses today—and for generations to come—have access to the education, resources, and opportunities they need to improve the lives of patients with cancer. 

Our funding supports groundbreaking studies that pave the way for innovative therapies, address emerging challenges in the field, and empower nurses to improve patient outcomes. Tracking ONF-funded studies highlights the impact that oncology nursing research has on cancer care and the vital importance of continuing to fund innovative research to fulfill our mission . Through continuous investment in research, we strive to empower oncology nurses with the knowledge and tools necessary to deliver exceptional care, ultimately leading to better health and a higher quality of life for those affected by cancer.

■ Impact Highlight: Donna Berry



Donna Berry, PhD, RN, AOCN®, FAAN received her first research grant from ONF in 1995 for her study titled, "Measurement of Irritative Bladder Symptoms." In 1996, she continued her research with ONF funding in her study, "Relief Strategies for Irritative Bladder Symptoms Associated with Intravesical BCG." These two small research grants paved the way for the symptom management and self-care programs of research that have developed from 1999 to today.

Maintaining her momentum, Dr. Berry received funding of \$50,000 from ONF in 2001 for her study, "Computerized Cancer Symptom and Quality of Life Assessment." This study and its results served as preliminary data to support two follow-up RoI grants totaling more than \$1 million in funding, awarded to Dr. Berry in 2004 and 2007. These grants allowed Dr. Berry and her team to establish the Electronic Self Report Assessment-Cancer (ESRA-C)

program, a confidential, electronic self-report method for patients to report symptoms and concerns, as an efficacious intervention. A new version of the ESRA-C program has since been implemented clinically within healthcare platforms like MyChart and EPIC.

ONF awarded an additional small grant to Dr. Berry in 2003 for the study "Information Needs of Men with Prostate Cancer During Radiation," which provided results that were used as a basis for designing and conducting three subsequent National Institutes of Health grants.

Dr. Berry's research has shaped not only her own career trajectory but also two critical areas of oncology nursing: cancer treatment decision-making and patient-centered self-care and communication. Equally meaningful is the impact her ONF-supported work has had on the next generation of nurse scientists and trainees, many of whom joined her funded research teams and flourished under her mentorship. Their continued success stands as a testament to the ripple effect of early research investment. Dr. Berry's story illustrates the lasting value of ONF funding, not only in advancing science but also in cultivating leaders who will drive the future of oncology nursing forward.



ONF-funded research has been pivotal in advancing oncology nursing practice and elevating the standard of care for our patients. The Foundation's support has been instrumental in shaping my own research journey, allowing me to explore critical questions that were extended in long-term programs of research that not only have significantly improved patient outcomes, but also facilitated the scholarship of mentees and countless others in the field. Because of this impact, I not only value ONF's contributions—I also believe in investing back into the Foundation to ensure future innovations. I encourage others to join me in supporting this essential work that benefits both our profession and the patients we care for.
