



Academic Scholarships

ONF provides scholarships for nursing students pursuing BSN, MSN, DNP or PhD degrees annually.

BSN Scholarship	\$3,000
MSN Scholarship	\$5,000
DNP/PhD Scholarships	\$7,500

Important Deadlines:

Application Opens - **September**
Applications Due – **February**

Applicants are notified of funding by the end of April; funds are released after July 1st

Professional Development & Leadership Funding

ONF provides scholarships and awards to awaken leadership potential in oncology nurses and encourage life-long learning.

Conference Scholarship Funding

ONF provides travel scholarships to support oncology nurses who are attending nursing conferences.

Josh Gottheil TCTCN™ Career Development Award

Funded by the Josh Gottheil Memorial Fund for Lymphoma Research, this award funds multiple awards annually.

Supports recipients with up to \$2,000 for registration, travel, lodging and conference-related costs for attendance at a transplantation conference of the recipient's choice.

Leadership Scholarship

Funded by the ONS Past President fund, ONCC Emerging Leaders fund, and the Sandy Purl fund.

Supports a registered nurse, working in oncology, interested in developing their leadership skills to improve cancer care by attending a leadership continuing education program.

Awards up to \$3,000 for registration fees to attend conference virtually or in-person.

Application Opens - **March**
Applications Due – **September**

ONS Congress® Scholarship

Supported by the Oncology Nursing Foundation, Nancy Berkowitz Scholarship fund, Ron Schlesinger Scholarship fund, Oncology Hematology Care, Inc., Siouxland Chapter fund, CEBONS Karen Zapotoski Memorial ONS Congress Scholarship, Napa Valley Chapter Fund, and the Susie Maloney Scholarship fund.

Oncology Nurse Scientist Research Grants Overview

Oncology Nurse Scientist Research Intensive

A research mentoring and networking opportunity for PhD nurse scientists to expand the scientific foundation for oncology nursing practice and improvement of the healthcare of people impacted by cancer.

Brings together a cohort of early-career nurse scientists paired with senior research scientist mentors. This program is held in-person at the ONS Congress®.

Up to \$1,400 reimbursement for travel, lodging and meals during attendance

Applicants are notified by March

General Topic Research Grants

Supports rigorous scientific oncology nursing research projects that involve nurses in the design and conduct of the research activity and that promote theoretically-based oncology practice.

RE03 – \$50,000 over two-year funding period:

- PI must be a doctorally-prepared nurse scientist
- Must have a member of the research team who of \$100,000 in funding

RE33 - \$100,000 over two-year funding period:

- PI must be a doctorally-prepared nurse scientist
- PI must have completed at least one grant of at least has completed research \$50,000 in funding
